



Year 2 Newsletter

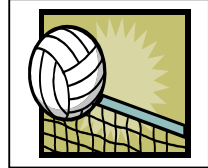


Topic

Literacy

In the first four weeks our literacy lessons will be based upon books written by significant authors, such as Roald Dahl, Martin Waddell, Dick King Smith and Julia Donaldson. The children will be learning how to compare story characters and write narratives. They will also learn how to use texts for information in a non-chronological form.

Science

We will be learning about Plants and Animals in science and how to care for our pets. Following on from that, we will be looking at Health and Growth. This teaches the children about their own physical development, and how to keep healthy.



RE

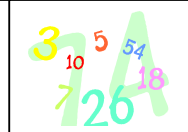
We will be thinking about places of worship in RE.
